

# The “One Anothers” of Scripture

## Accept

“Wherefore, *accept one another*, just as Christ also accepted us to the glory of God.”  
**Romans 15:7**

## Admonish

“And concerning you, my brethren, I myself also am convinced that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, and able also to *admonish one another*.”  
**Romans 15:14**

“Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and *admonishing one another* with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God. **Colossians 3:16**

## Bear Burdens

“*Bear one another’s* burdens, and thus fulfill the law of Christ. **Galatians 6:2**

## Bearing With and Forgiving

“And so, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience; *bearing with one another*, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.” **Colossians 3:12,13**

## Build Up and Encourage

“So then let us *pursue* the things which make for *peace* and the *building up* of **one another**.” **Romans 14:19**

“Therefore *encourage one another*, and *build up one another*, just as you also are doing.” **1 Thessalonians 5:11**

“But *encourage one another* day after day, as long as it is still called “Today,” lest any one of you be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.” **Hebrews 3:13**

“and let us consider how to *stimulate one another* to love and good deeds, not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but *encouraging one another*; and all the more, as you see the day drawing near.” **Hebrews 10:24,25**

### **Care For**

“But God has so composed the body, giving more abundant honor to that member which lacked, that there should be no division in the body, but that the members should have the same *care for one another*.” **1 Corinthians 12:24-25**

### **Comfort**

“Therefore, *comfort one another* with these words.” **1 Thessalonians 4:18**

### **Confess and Pray For**

“Therefore, *confess* your sins to **one another**, and *pray* for **one another**, so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much. **James 5:16**

### **Devoted To**

“*Be devoted* to **one another** in brotherly love; *give preference* to **one another** in honor;” **Romans 12:10**

### **Fellowship With**

“But if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have *fellowship with one another*, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.” **1 John 1:7**

### **Forbearance To**

“with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing *forbearance to one another* in love.” **Ephesians 4:2**

## **Greet**

"Greet **one another** with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ greet you." **Romans 16:16**

"All the brethren greet you. Greet **one another** with a holy kiss." **1 Corinthians 16:20**

"Greet **one another** with a holy kiss." **2 Corinthians 13:12**

"Greet **one another** with a kiss of love." **1 Peter 5:14**

## **Hospitable To**

"Be *hospitable to one another* without complaint." **1 Peter 4:9**

## **Humility Toward**

"You younger men, likewise, be subject to your elders; and all of you, clothe yourselves with *humility toward one another*, for God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble." **1 Peter 5:5**

## **Kind To and Forgiving**

"And be *kind to one another*, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you." **Ephesians 4:32**

## **Live In Peace With**

"Live in peace with **one another**." **1 Thessalonians 5:13**

## **Love**

"A new commandment I give to you, that you *love one another* even, as I have loved you also *love one another*." **John 13:34**

"By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have *love* for **one another**." **John 13:35**

"This is My commandment, that you *love one another*, just as I have loved you." **John 15:12**

"This is I command you, that you *love one another*." **John 15:17**

"Owe nothing to anyone except to *love one another*, for he who loves his neighbor has fulfilled the law." **Romans 13:8**

"and may the Lord cause you to increase and abound in *love for one another*, and for all men, just as we also do for you." **1 Thessalonians 3:12**

"Now as to the love of the brethren, you have no need for anyone to write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to *love one another*" **1 Thessalonians 4:9**

"We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brethren, as is only fitting, because your faith is greatly enlarged, and the *love* of each one of you toward *one another* grows ever greater;" **2 Thessalonians 1:3**

## **Members Of**

"Therefore, laying aside falsehood, speak truth, each one of you, with his neighbor, for we are *members of one another*." **Ephesians 4:25**

## **Peace With**

"Salt is good; but if the salt becomes unsalty, with what will you make it salty again? Have salt in yourselves, and be at *peace with one another*. **Mark 9:50**

## Regard

"Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind let each of you *regard one another* as more important than himself; do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.

**Philippians 2:3,4**

## Same Mind Toward

"*Be of the same mind toward one another*, do not be haughty in mind, but associate with the lowly. Do not be wise in your own estimation." **Romans 12:16**

"Now may the God who gives perseverance and encouragement grant you to *be of the same mind* with *one another* according to Christ Jesus." **Romans 15:5**

## Seek Good For

"See that no one repays another with evil for evil, but always *seek* after that which is *good for one another*." **1 Thessalonians 5:15**

## Serve

"For you were called to freedom, brethren; only do not turn your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, but through love *serve one another*." **Galatians 5:13**

"As each one has received a special gift, employ it in *servicing one another*, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. **1 Peter 4:10**

## Subject To

"and be *subject to one another* in the fear of Christ." **Ephesians 5:21**

## Wait For

"So then my brethren, when you come together to eat, *wait for one another*." **1 Corinthians 11:33**

## **Do Not Bite and Devour**

“But if you *bite and devour* **one another**, take care lest you be *consumed* by **one another**.” **Galatians 5:15**

## **Do Not Complain Against**

“Do not *complain*, brethren, *against* **one another**, that you yourselves may not be judged; behold, the Judge is standing right at the door.” **James 5:9**

## **Do Not Challenge and Envy**

“Let us not become boastful, *challenging* **one another**, *envying* **one another**.” **Galatians 5:26**

## **Do Not Hate**

“For we also once were foolish ourselves, disobedient, deceived, enslaved to various lusts and pleasures, spending our life in malice and envy, hateful, *hating* **one another**.” **Titus 3:3**

## **Do Not Injure**

“And on the following day he appeared to them as they were fighting together, and he tried to reconcile them in peace, saying, ‘Men, you are brethren, why do you *injure* **one another**?’” **Acts 7:26**

## **Do Not Have Lawsuits With**

“Actually, then, it is already a defeat for you, that you have *lawsuits* with **one another**. Why not rather be wronged? Why not rather be defrauded?” **1 Corinthians 6:7**

## **Do Not Judge**

“Therefore *let us not judge* **one another** anymore, but rather determine this – not to put an obstacle or a stumbling block in a brother’s way.” **Romans 14:13**

## **Do Not Lie To**

“*Do not lie to one another*, since you laid aside the old self with its evil practices.”  
**Colossians 3:9**

## **Do Not Speak Against**

“Do not *speak against one another*, brethren. He who speaks against a brother, or judges his brother, speaks against the law, and judges the law; but if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law, but a judge of it.” **James 4:11**

## **Do Not Wrong**

“So you shall not *wrong one another*, but shall fear your God, for I am the Lord your God.” **Leviticus 25:17**
